Georgie Adams \$29.95

Story of Trixy, Tammy and Trig, three little girl pirates who have a big adventure

Belonging

Jeannie Baker \$27.95

Superbly illustrated story with no words. Illustrations show the changes over time in an inner city neighbourhood. Shows how relationship with nature and the land can be maintained in the city.

Mummy Never Told Me

Babette Cole \$19.95

A fun and useful expose of the questions children love to ask about life's little mysteries. Gorgeous!

Prince Cinders

Babette Cole \$12.95

Prince Cinders loved to clean and scrub, and he was bullied by his three ugly brothers. One day a fairy promised that all his wishes would come true. Other beautiful books by Cole include *Dr Dog*, *Two Of Everything*, *Mummy Laid An Egg*, and *Hair In Funny Places*.
