Everyone's Got A Bottom

Tess Rowley \$18.95

Story about Ben, his brother, and sister, talking and learning together about how to keep their bodies safe. Excellent tool for parents and carers to start a conversation about protective behavior. Lovely illustrations. NEW 2007

NoNo The Little Seal

Sherri Patterson & Judith Feldman \$37.95

BACK IN PRINT: gentle story of a little seal who learns to stay safe, say NO, and tell secrets that should not be hidden. Includes a CD with story and songs.

Rosy and Jack

Nicole Reading \$35.75

Rosy and Jack are a sister and brother who have had bad things done to them. A picture book for children and parents about courage, hope and healing after child sexual abuse.

It's My Body

Lory Freeman \$15.95

Simple drawings and story teach children about good touching and unpleasant touching. Children learn that it's OK to say, "Don't touch me. I don't like it".

Lory Freeman \$12.95

Something Is Wrong At My House

Diane Davis \$12.95

A story about a little boy living in a violent household who learns to find help with his feelings of hopelessness, fear and anger.

Something Happened And I'm Scared To Tell

Patricia Kehoe \$12.95

A friendly lion talks to an unhappy child who is being abused and touched in a way that is frightening. The child is encouraged to talk about bottled-up worries. A good story for encouraging self-esteem.

Something Happened To Me

Phyllis Sweet \$32.95

For young children, talking about feelings, touching and secrets.

Uncle Willy's Tickles

Marcie Aboff \$22.95

Teaches the important concept that your body belongs to you. Children can and should express themselves if they feel uncomfortable about something.

Katie's Yucky Problem

Linda Morgan \$7.65

Katie's friend tells her that she is frightened of her father's best friend. The story explores Katie's dilemma of whether to tell and who to tell. Gives positive ideas of outcomes.

Your Body Belongs To You

Cornelia Spelman \$12.95

Children learn to respect their own choices about being touched.

We Can Get Along

Lauren Murphy \$23.95

A child's book of choices, teaching essential skills in a way young children can understand, shows children how to respect themselves and others. Beautifully illustrated.

My Body Is Private

Linda Girard \$13.95

A good story teaching children to be assertive and positive about what is private. Looks at good touching and unwelcome touching.

The Right Touch
